How to Call Your Member of Congress

1) Call the Capitol Hill main line: 202-224-3121

2) Ask to be connected to each of your Senator's offices, and also your Representative's office.

3) The front office will answer the phone. Politely tell the staff member who answers the phone that you have an opinion on **global health and foreign aid** that you would like to share with the member of Congress and ask if you can leave that opinion with the staffer.

4) Deliver your talking points.

- Funding UN agencies that prevent diseases around the world is a smart investment. Every dollar invested in vaccines returns an average of \$16 in economic savings and avoided healthcare costs.
- Stopping diseases before they reach our country protects the health of Americans at home and abroad. A disease anywhere is a threat to everyone, so until we eliminate these threats we are all at risk.
