
### WHO WE ARE

## THE RESULTS



Shot@Life gave more of the world's children access to lifesaving vaccines in 2024:



As a result of our **advocacy work**, **congressional appropriators once again approved an FY25 budget that robustly fund global immunization programs**. Because that budget still awaits passage by the full Congress, Shot@Life continues to advocate for it. U.S. investments are vital to reaching the millions of children who lack access to health care and face crises like conflict, displacement, and climate disasters.



Our **direct grants** to UN partners — UNICEF; WHO; UNHCR; and Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance — helped deliver an additional 9.2 million vaccines to children who needed them. **Since the campaign's founding, Shot@Life has helped provide more than 130 million vaccines to children around the world.** 

# Giving Refugee Children a Healthy Start

In 2024 we launched of *Healthy Start for Refugee Children*, a special initiative of Shot@Life and United to Beat Malaria that, in partnership with the UN Refugee Agency (UNHCR), aims to deliver essential health services to one million refugee and displaced children living in East Africa. The success of this two-year fundraising campaign will not only ensure refugee children receive the health services they urgently need, but also deliver related health education and strengthen healthcare systems so host countries can better meet the needs of displaced families moving forward.





# Partner Spotlight: Get a Shot. Give a Shot.®

Each flu season since 2012, Walgreens matched vaccinations administered at their pharmacies with a donation of a measles or polio vaccine to a child in need. In 2024, the Get a Shot.
